Instructor Certification Procedure for AML Trainers

This procedure ensures that all instructors meet high standards of knowledge, professionalism, and training delivery.

Eligibility Criteria

Who qualifies to apply as a certified instructor:

- Minimum 5+ years of AML/Compliance experience.
- Holds CASS or equivalent AML certification (e.g., ICA, CAMS, CFCS).
- Proven track record in training, compliance leadership, or investigations.
- Strong presentation and communication skills.
- Experience with live and online training formats.

Application Process:

- 1. Complete an instructor application form.
- 2. Submit mandatory documentation.
- 3. Complete AML knowledge test (or an interview if applicable)



Screening & Knowledge Assessment

Step 1: Complete the Certified AML Trainer Application Form

- Complete the CAT application form
- Send the form with necessary attachments (CV, certificates, training samples etc.) to the email of the respective agent.

Step 2: AML Knowledge Test

- 50-question multiple-choice exam on AML regulations, risk-based approaches, and case studies.
- Passing score: 80% minimum.
